

How can I let the school know I am concerned about my child's progress in school?

- If you have concerns about your child's progress, you should speak to your child's class teacher **initially**.
- If you are not happy that the concerns are being managed and that your child is still not making progress, you should speak to the SENCo or Head Teacher.
- If you are still not happy, you can speak to the school SEND Governor.
