Child Protection

Pastoral Care

This year, Mrs Mason (Family Support), Mrs Stevens (Attendance) and Mr Aymer (Emotional Health and Well Being) will be working with the school to support families and children.

Attendance and Punctuality

It is vital that children attend regularly and arrive punctually if they are to make progress in their learning.

Poor attendance and punctuality severely limits this learning and can cause them to fall behind their peers and often struggle to catch up. Our 'Wise Up' Attendance Programme rewards good attendance and each term 'Gold' or 'Silver' certificates will be given out for excellent attendance.

Absence during term-time-please note holidays during term time will not be authorised and if taken could result in a fine.

School starts at <u>8.45 am</u> and <u>12.30 pm</u> for Nursery children and <u>8.55 am</u> for children in Reception to Year 6, finishing at <u>3.30 pm</u>.

The school gates will be locked at 9 am each morning to ensure the safety of the children.

If your child arrives after this time, then they must be escorted by their parent to the main office.

Please inform, or make the teachers aware of who is picking up your child from school. If this changes, then please contact the school office to let us know – thank you for your co-operation.

School Meals

If your child's lunchtime arrangement has changed from last year, please could you inform the school office. If you pay for your child's meal, then please send this into school in a clearly named envelope every Monday. The price of a school meal is £2.25 per day, £11.25 per week. Thank you.

School Tuck

At break time we have toast, yoghurt ,milk or fruit juice to buy from our school kitchen.

All Infant children also have the opportunity to have a free piece of fruit.

Please note other items for first break are not allowed apart from fruit, which Junior children can bring in if they wish. (No chocolate bars, crisps, sweets etc).

Parking

Shawsdale Road is a very narrow road and at the beginning and end of the school day is extremely busy.

Please do always think of the safety of the children and other people if driving.

Please park correctly and think whether pedestrians can get safely past. Our church car park is always available.

Our neighbours would really appreciate people not parking across their drives as they may need to get out too!

With thought and respect for others, the school drop off and pick up can be less stressful and safer for our children.
