Welcome back to the new school term and a Happy New Year to you all.

The children have settled back into the school routine quickly and are full of energy and ready for the challenges ahead. As always your continued support at home will help them achieve their best.

## <u> Attendance – 'Wise Up'</u>

Our 'Wise Up' Campaign for Autumn 2016 resulted in 66% of the children receiving a Gold or Silver certificate representing attendance of over 95% - very well done to all those children who achieved this.

'Wise Up' has begun for the Spring term so everyone potentially has the chance to get a Gold or Silver certificate for this term!

Please do remember that school starts at 8.55 am and it is important that children are 'on time in the line' so as to avoid an unsettled start to the day.

We still have a number of children consistently arriving after the beginning of school.

Our Education Social Worker, Corrinne Atkin, continues to work with those families whose children's attendance is low, with the aim of supporting them to bring about improvements.

Unfortunately, if despite this support attendance continues to be an issue, then court action becomes necessary.

## **Extreme Weather**

A reminder of arrangements in the event of school closure. The procedure will be:

- 1) Listen to local radio stations, Heart FM, Radio WM and Free Radio who will be informed of school closures and will announce the closure on air and update their websites of the closures.
- 2) We will use the Groupcall texting service to send a text to you please ensure your mobile is turned on and we have your up to date mobile details in school. (please could you notify school if you have not been receiving group texts we have previously sent)
- 3) Check the school website and the Birmingham City Council disruption website.

Each year we ask you to complete a few short questions about the school.

## Water Mains work
