## Maths Progression from EYFS - Y1

The children will be learning to counts objects, actions and sounds and subitise up to 4 or 5 objects. They witt learn to link the number yalue The children will count beyond ben value. The children wand understand the 'one core than/one less than' relationship between consecutive numbers. The children will select, rotate and manipulate shapes in order to develop spatial reasoning skills. They will compose and decompose shapes so that they can recognise that a shape can have other shapes within it, just as numbers can.

The children will be learning to develop fast recognition of up to 3 objects, without having to count them individually ('subitising'). They will be reciting numbers past 5 and saying one number for each item in order: $1,2,3,4,5$. They will also show 'finger numbers' up to 5 and link numerals and amounts. The children will talk about and explore 2D and 3D shapes using informal and mathematical language: 'sides',
