### Saint John Henry Newman

On Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> October 2019, Blessed John Henry Newman will be Canonised at a ceremony in St Peter's Square, Rome. This means that he will become a Saint. He will be the first English person in over 50 years to become a Saint. Newman was a Catholic Priest known for his kindness and compassion and had a special relationship with the people of Birmingham: he was the founder of the first Oratorian order of Priests in North Birmingham and was the founder of The Oratory School in Edgbaston. Today, a number of educational establishments honour his name: Newman University College in South Birmingham, where many of our teachers here at St Wilfrid's trained and, of course, John Henry Newman Catholic

College - our local secondary school in Chelmsley Wood.

We have celebrated this in school and our Year 5 children were invited to join the celebrations at John Henry Newman Catholic College. Also, this week, we welcomed Mr Morgan from John Henry Newman Catholic College, who led an assembly for us.
