- We hope it will be a space where we can grow things.

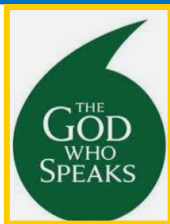

This half term, our focus is on **The Dignity of the Worker**.

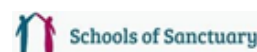
Children have been learning about how **EVERYONE**
