ParentPay

We will shortly be accepting payments online for school meals and trips. Attendance

Our target for the year is at least 95.5% attendance for the whole school. At present our school attendance is 94.4%. Frequent absence can add up to a considerable amount of lost learning and can seriously disadvantage your child in adult life.

- 5 minutes late every day means around 3.5 days of education missed
- a score of 90% in a test would be a good result but 90% attendance means that a child will have missed around 100 lessons over a school year!

Every minute counts - examples				
Attendance during one school year	equals this number of days absent	which is approximately this many weeks absent	which means this number of lessons missed	
95%	9 days	2 weeks	50 lessons	
90%	19 days	4 weeks	100 lessons	
85%	29 days	6 weeks	150 lessons	
80%	38 days	8 weeks	200 lessons
