

School Admission Appeal Timetable 2022

Appeals for normal round of admissions	
Please note that current government legislation requires all appeals up to the 30th September 2022 to be heard by video conferencing, where they cannot be heard face to face due to COVID reasons.	
Date of allocation of places:	Tuesday 19 th April 2022
Deadline for lodging appeals and providing evidence to support the appeal (if appropriate):	Wednesday 18 th May 2022
Appeals will be heard:	w/c: 4 th July 2022
Appeals venue:	Whilst social distancing is in place – appeals will be heard via conference call
Notice of appeal hearing:	At least fourteen calendar days before the appeal hearing date
Deadline for governing body to submit evidence for the appeal:	Monday 13 th June 2022
Deadline for sending appeal papers to all parties:	No later than fourteen calendar days before the appeal hearing
Deadline for appellant to submit additional evidence:	Seven calendar days before the appeal hearing. Information or evidence not submitted by the deadline might not be considered at the appeal
Late applications for appeals will be heard by:	At the same time as previously scheduled appeals or as soon as is reasonable practicable if not.
Decision letter to be appellant: (Clerk to the panel responsibility)	Normally within seven calendar days of appeal hearing

Appeals for in-year admissions	
Deadline for lodging appeals and providing evidence to support the appeal (if appropriate):	Twenty eight calendar days from the date of notification that the application was unsuccessful
Appeals will be heard:	Current temporary legislation states that appeals should be determined as soon as it is reasonably practicable.
Notice of appeal hearing:	At least fourteen calendar days before the appeal hearing date
Deadline for governing body to submit evidence for the appeal:	Fourteen calendar days before the appeal hearing date.
Deadline for sending appeal papers to all parties:	No later than fourteen calendar days before the appeal hearing
Deadline for appellant to submit additional evidence:	Seven calendar days before the appeal hearing. Information or evidence not submitted by the deadline might not be considered at the appeal.
Late applications for appeals will be heard:	At the same time as previously scheduled appeals or as soon as is reasonable practicable if not.
Decision letters sent to the appellant (Clerk to the panel responsibility)	Normally within seven calendar days of appeal hearing
