### 'Our Lady and All Saints' Academy Consultation

St Wilfrid's Catholic Primary School has been working with other Catholic schools in the local area to establish a Multi Academy Company. All schools are now consulting on the planned changes and a meeting has been arranged in **St Wilfrid's School** on **Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 at 6 pm in the School Hall** to explain what is involved. A Consultation Information booklet has been put on our school website.

### Harvest Festival – Friday 20<sup>th</sup> September, 2019

In Collective Worship this week the children have been learning about our new virtues for the half term – Grateful and Generous. The children have realised that not everyone is as lucky as us with access to nutritious food, so we should always be grateful to God for what we have and generous with what we do have. On **Monday 16<sup>th</sup> September, 2019** there will be a **Non-Uniform Day** in return for the children bringing in any long life items such as pasta, packets of rice, tinned food (fish, vegetables, fruit, soups), cup of soups and oil. These goods will be donated to St Chad's Sanctuary in Birmingham City Centre. St Chad's helps lots of families including refugees. All children "have the right to good quality health care, clean water and good food" – (UNICEF rights of the child – Article 24).

### Life Caravan

On **Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> September, 2019** the Life Caravan will be in school until **Friday 20<sup>th</sup> September, 2019**. During the visit the children will have opportunities to learn about healthy eating, being kind to each other and medicine safety. Older children will focus on making safe and healthy choices.

On **Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> September, 2019** there will be a Parent Session from **9-9.15 am** – please come along and find out what the children will be learning and see the caravan.
