Poppy Appeal

Poppies will continue to be on sale at school. The children have been learning about the significance of them, that they are a symbol of both Remembrance and hope for a peaceful future.

On Sunday there will be many events commemorating Remembrance Sunday including the National Service of Remembrance at the Cenotaph in London, remembering the service and sacrifice of men and women in the two World Wars and later conflicts.

In school we will hold a two minute silence at 11 am on Monday to remember the brave men and women who have served us so well in the armed forces. We particularly remember Joseph Murphy, a past pupil, who was killed in action in Afghanistan.

Anti-Bullying Week

National Anti-Bullying week begins on Monday 11th November. The key focus being 'Change Starts with Us', making all people aware that making a Small change can make a Big difference.

The children will explore the theme, thinking about what bullying is and is not, how it can affect others and what we can do to make a difference.
