Anti Bullying Week – 12th – 16th November, 2018

Next week school will be participating, once again, in the National Anti-Bullying programme. The theme this year is 'Choose Respect' - to choose respect over bullying.

Following a consultation with over 800 children, teachers and members of the Anti-Bullying Alliance, it emerged that a top priority was showing that bullying is a behaviour choice and that children can set a positive example by opting to respect each other at school, in their homes and communities, and online.

During the week children will be exploring the theme, thinking about what bullying is and is not, how it can affect others and what to do if we are experiencing bullying.

As we always do, we will be reminding the children that we are a 'TELLING' school, and that if we are upset or unhappy about something, not to 'bottle it up' but tell an adult so something can be done.
