# Ash Wednesday - Wednesday 26th February, 2020

We will be celebrating mass on the Wednesday and the children will have the opportunity to receive the ashes on their forehead.

The ashes are traced in the form of a cross and they mark the beginning of the season of Lent; a time of prayer, penance and alms-giving.

Mass will be at 9.05 am and all parents are welcome to join us.

During Lent there will be a non-uniform day each Friday, for which we ask for a donation of £1 per family each week. This money will be split between our 3 school Lenten charities: Cafod, Father Hudson's and The Birmingham Catholic Primary Partnership Rwanda Project.

The money raised for Cafod, this year, will go to inhabitants of the Rainforest, where, every minute a football pitch sized piece of the Rainforest is destroyed. In recognition of this, the non-uniform on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> February will be football themed. Children may come dressed in a football kit or any other football themed clothing.

In addition to this, each class has chosen a charity that is special to them. They will be finding out about the charity and thinking about how they can help.
