## **Important Reminders**

In order to be able to continue to drive down infection rates and thus keep our schools open, we must remember the government message of 'Hands. Face. Space'.

- All adults <u>must</u> wear face coverings when on the school site (unless you have a medical exemption).
- We ask, wherever possible, that only one adult comes to drop off or collect their children.
- Please ensure you do not mix with other households and you keep 2 metre distance between adults.
- While tempting, as we will not have seen others for some time, do not congregate on the school playgrounds or the school gates.

## School Day Timings

# Nursery, Year 1, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 - Start 8.45 am Finish Time 3.15 pm Reception, Year 2, Year 3 - Start 9 am Finish Time 3.30 pm

These times are staggered to cut down on congestion on the playgrounds and Shawsdale Road.

Please note, the school gates will be open from 8.30 am to allow a 'trickle in' system, again to cut down on congestion. Staff will be carrying out Lateral Flow Tests twice weekly, but our children will not.

It is very important that if children are unwell with Covid symptoms, they <u>do not</u> come to school and a Covid test is conducted.
