Covid-19

As we move further away from Covid -19 restrictions, it is a good time to update you on the new guidelines that we are bound to follow in school.

What will be different?

- Twice weekly asymptomatic testing is no longer required.
- Wearing of face coverings in communal areas is no longer required.

What will stay the same?

- It is no longer a legal requirement to isolate for 5 days or more, up to a limit of 10 days, depending on when 2 negative LFDs are received. However, WE WOULD STRONGLY ADVISE YOU TO DO THIS and our advice to staff is the same.
- We will ensure good hygiene, cleaning and ventilation

It is also important to note that, in the event of an outbreak, we may be advised to return to testing, face coverings or other measures.

Lost Property

We have, once again, gathered a large amount of lost property. It will be laid out on tables in the playground each night next week and, at the end of the week, whatever is not claimed will be donated to charity.
