Year 6 Confirmation

I am very pleased to say that we were able to go ahead with the Confirmation of our Year 6 children on Wednesday of this week.

It was a lovely celebration with the children showing great reverence and maturity throughout. Bishop David, who conducted the celebration, was very impressed with their knowledge of their saints and the confident response of the children - well done and congratulations.

Covid -19

Last week resulted in many of our children having to self-isolate due to a small number of children testing positive on Lateral Flow Tests. Like all schools, and having spoken with other headteachers in the Our Lady and All Saint MAC, these occurrences are increasing, not just here but also in the MAC, but also across the country and more and more class bubbles are having to self-isolate. We will always follow the guidance and work with Public Health England when there are positive cases in school but there are some things that we ask all parents to do.

1) If your child is unwell, do not send to school, self-isolate the whole family and carry out a Lateral Flow Test (LFT) with your child. These can be ordered, or collected, from chemists and medical centres. I also know that colleagues from Birmingham City Council have been distributing them at supermarkets.

IF THE TEST IS POSITIVE THEN DO NOT SEND THEM INTO SCHOOL AND BOOK IN FOR A PCR TEST.

These can be booked on the NHS website or Gov.uk website. If this returns a negative result then the children can return to school.

Please be aware there have been some reports recently of other symptoms like sore throats, headaches, congestion or runny noses or vomiting that have been signs of Covid.

If unwell - DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL, CARRY OUT A LFT FIRST.

- 2) Ensure the "hands, face, space, fresh air" message is acted on.
- 3) Face masks must be worn when on the school site, unless you have a medical exemption.
- 4) Keep at least 2 metres distance between other adults not in your family 'bubble'.

On Monday 5th July 2021 Reception and Years 2, 3 and 5 can return to school and Year 1 can return on Tuesday 6th July 2021.
